

Sink

- Sink Faucet (not included)
- Sink Drain (not included)


NOTE: Specialized tools may be necessary to install a Vessel Sink with countertop materials other than wood, marble, or granite.



- 1. Read the complete instruction manual before beginning installation.
- 2. Confirm that your model will fit in intended location and plumbing fixtures are located where legally required before beginning installation.
- 3. Two people are recommended to install and move this product.

1. Mark Faucet Holes and Drain Location

· Place sink in desired location on countertop and mark the drain hole and faucet hole with a pencil. NOTE: Make sure clearance is suitable for backsplash, faucet, and plumbing for the sin



2. Drill Countertop


· Cut the opening for the drain in the countertop.

3. Install Faucet

· Install faucet and its components.



4. Install Sink

- · Check alignment of the sink to the opening in the countertop.
- · Use a bead of clear silicone (or preferred adhesive) around the underside of the sink.
- · Carefully place the sink on the countertop, align, and press firmly.
- · Allow sealant to set above 60 minutes.

Installer Tip: Use acetone or denatured alcohol to remove any excess sealant immediately after application.
