

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Parts Included

1 Straight Rod (84" and 96" rods come as two pieces)
2 #310 Flanges
Mounting Hardware

Tools Needed

Small Blade Screwdriver • Phillips Screwdriver • Level • Drill with 1/8" Bit •
 Pipe Cutter / Hacksaw (Optional) •



- 1. Measure wall opening.
- 2. Place the two ends of the rod together, if it came as two pieces.
- 3. Measure rod. You can cut both ends to shorten rod. You can increase size by sliding flange out up to 1/2" (1" total). For best results, have rods extend into flange up to the end of the guides inside the flange.
- 4. When desired size is achieved, slide flanges on each end and install rod in opening.

 ** Do Not use set screws yet. **
- 5. After rod is secured to walls, use a level to make sure rod is level side to side and front to back. Now install set screws. A 1/8" pilot hole is recommended for optimum strength.
