## **INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS**

## Parts Included

• 1 Straight Center Rod • 2 Bent End Rods (end pre-plugged for flange) • 2 I-140 Plastic Inserts • • 2 #300 Flanges • 8 Wood Screws • 2 Set Screws •

## **Tools Needed**

Small Blade Screwdriver • Phillips Screwdriver • Level • Drill with 1/8" Bit •
• Pipe Cutter / Hacksaw •



- 1. Measure wall opening.
- 2. Tap I-140 insert halfway into straight rod on each end.
- 3. Push left bent end rod onto straight rod until both ends meet.
- 4. Lay connected rods on flat surface and assemble right bent end rod. As in step #3.
- 5. Measure rod. You can cut ends up to 1 1/2" off each end (3" total) to shorten rod. You can increase size by sliding flange out up to 1/2" (1" total). For best results, have rods extend into flange up to the end of the guides inside the flange.
- 6. When desired size is achieved, slide flanges on each end and install rod in opening.

  \*\* Do Not use set screws yet. \*\*
- 7. After rod is secured to walls, use a level to make sure rod is level side to side and front to back. Now install set screws. A 1/8" pilot hole is recommended for optimum strength.
