



Important

- We recommend that this product is installed by a qualified professional plumber / contractor.
- Please check this product immediately to ensure that it has not been damaged and is complete. Before installation, please make sure this product is the correct model and you have all the parts required for installation and using.
- Please flush the water system to ensure that no metal swarf, solder, and other impurities can enter the taps.
- Turn off water supply before commencing work, this should be done at the isolating valves of inlet feeds if fitted or main stopcock.
- Please read these instructions carefully and keep it for future reference.

Cleaning

- Before use: Unscrew the Aerator and allow the water to run freely for 5 minutes. Then screw the filter back in place.
- Periodically: Unscrew the Aerator and remove. Rinse it with running water until any loose debris is cleared. Then replace the Aerator and tighten.








Maintenance

We DO NOT recommend using any household cleaners to clean the product. The product should be cleaned only with soapy water. Rinsed with clean water and dry with a soft cloth.

Faucet Installation Procedure

Recommended Tools

Shut off main water supply before installation



- 1. Fit the washer into the groove at the underside of the mixer body.
- 2. Screw the hoses into the mixer body, and fully hand tighten.
- 3. Pass the tail of flexible pipes through the hole on the basin from above, and place the mixer in position on the basin, to see if any alteration to the existing supply pipe work is necessary, make any necessary alterations to the pipe work.
- 4. Tighten the rubber washer, the metal washer with the fixing nut from the under-side of the counter.
- 5. Check that the mixer body is correctly positioned, fully tighten the fixing nut.
- 6.Connect the water supply pipes to the tail of flexible hoses with the hot and cold water.
