



- This product should be installed by an experienced professional.
- Drain pipe is not supplied.
 Connect to an existing drain pipe.

Installation Instructions





PREPARE SHOWER PAN

- 1. Pre-slope shower pan and install waterproofing membrane per manufacturers instructions.
- 2. Perform a leak test as required.

IMPORTANT: Any waterproofing membrane material or procedure can be used: vinyl, CPE membrane, roll or paint on, metal pan, hot mop, surface sheet membrane.

PRE-INSTALLATION PREPARATION

- 1. The Linear Drain channel width is 3-3/16". Confirm the rough opening is approximately 2" wider than the drain length to accommodate backer board and wall tile thickness.
- 2. Install the Standard 2" Clamping Floor Drain (not included).

3. Cut a 2x4 to length for use as a Linear Drain placeholder. This allows for a 1/8" gap around the channel's perimeter to apply a bead of flexible sealant.

NOTE: Channel depths are 1.25" for the Tile Insert Linear Drain and .78" for the Grate Linear Drains.

TILE INSTALLATION

- 1. Using mortar, build up the shower base.
- Slope the mortar creating a 1-2% grade towards the drain.

IMPORTANT: Allow the mortar to cure overnight before installing tiles.

- 3. Using a thinset mortar, install the floor tile and entire shower alcove.
- 4. If using Tile Insert Linear Drain, install the tile into the tile insert tray.
- 5. Grout, clean and seal all tile in the shower area.


LINEAR DRAIN INSTALLATION

- 1. Remove the 2x4, clean out the void.
- 2. Screw the optional adapter into the drain hub to adjust the height of the channel.
- 3. Install the linear drain channel as you would any tile, building up and supporting as necessary with mortar. Ensure drain channel is level and just slightly below (1/6" or less) the adjacent tile.
- Line perimeter of linear drain channel with a colormatching, flexible waterproof sealant.


NOTE: This will allow the stainless steel to expand and contract without damaging the grout or tiles.

5. Assemble the Linear Drain by placing the hair strainer into the channel, then place the tray on top.


IMPORTANT: Use the lift-out key to pull the hair strainer out when you clean the drain.

Care & Maintenance



RECOMMENDED CLEANERS

For stains or light scratches, we suggest a mildly aggressive cleaner. You can also try a paste of baking soda and water, but be sure to rinse well and dry.

For stubborn stains and more noticeable scratches, we suggest a more aggressive cleaner such as Bar Keeper's Friend©. For extremely stubborn stains, you may also try to use a Scotch-Brite™ Pad. When using any of these cleaners, it is critical that you rub in the direction of the grain lines, rinse completely and towel dry.

SUGGESTED MAINTENANCE

- Do not use abrasives, sharp or scraping objects to clean your linear drain.
- The hair catcher should be cleaned periodically to remove any dirt that may have collected during regular use.

CAUTION

- Don't rub the across the satin finish lines. Scouring across the satin finish lines can damage the original finish.
- Don't allow soap or other household cleansers to dry on the surface of the linear drain. Most brands contain chemical additives which will affect the original finish.
- Don't use solutions of chlorine bleach and water in the drain. Chlorides, which are found in most soaps, detergents, bleaches, and cleansers, are very aggressive to stainless steel. If left too long, they can cause surface pitting.
- · Don't leave wet sponges, cloths, or cleaning pads on the linear drain. This can lead to surface rust.
- Don't use a steel wool pad to clean your linear drain. If a more abrasive product is needed, use a green Scotch-Brite™ pad, being sure to rub in the direction of the satin finish lines. Steel wool pads have a tendency to break apart and small particles of steel can become embedded in the surface of the linear drain. The steel particles will rust and will give the appearance that the drain itself is rusting.
