#### **BEFORE YOU START**

- Be sure to completely read this installation and maintenance guide before removing vanity top from box and installing.
- CAUTION: This vanity top is heavy. We recommend two people for lifting and installing. REmember to bend at the knees, not at the waist when lifting heavy objects.
- IMPORTANT: The vanity top must be installed, secured, plumb, and level. Failure of this step can lead to product damage.
- Cahaba is not responsible for sink or countertop if damaged during installation. Be sure to inspect the sink for damage prior to beginning installation.
- Your vanity top is made of natural stone quarried from the earth. Every slab
  of natural stone has its own unique characteristics, such as veining and
  coloration. Be sure to fully inspect your top for satisfaction before installation.
- · Follow all local plumbing and building codes.







## **INSTALL THE COUNTERTOP**

Prepare and level the vanity cabinet and secure it to the wall. Use additional interior supports if the vanity
is frameless or does not have full support around the frame. Your vanity top is heavy natural stone.
Additional wood suports should be 1" x 2" and affixes to the sides with caulking adhesive and short wood
screws that do not protrude through any exposed sides.

Be sure to follow the recommended instructions for installation from your vanity cabinet manufacturer.

- ► IMPORTANT: Be sure to hand tighten wing nuts on the bottom of your natural stone vanity top, that may have loosened during shipping, before attaching to vanity cabinet.
- 2. Apply a bead of silicone sealer on the top edges of the vanity cabinet. Place your natural stone top on it with an overhang of 1/2" on the edges and permit the sealer to dry. See the manufacturers instructions for drying time.
  - ▶ IMPORTANT: Cahaba is not responsible for sink or countertop if damaged during installation. Be sure to inspect the sink for damage prior to beginning installation.
  - ▶ IMPORTANT: Cahaba vanity tops should only be fastened to secure, level vanity cabinets.

## MAINTENANCE & CONSUMER RESPONSIBILITIES



Stone countertops (Granite, Marble, etc.) are surprisingly resilient to stains and scratches. However, as a preventative measure, any spills on the stone surfaces should be wiped up within a reasonable amount of time. Don't let liquid sit on the stone overnight. Stones are most prone to staining by oil and acid, so be sure to blot these spills up as soon as they happen. Follow up by cleaning the stone with a mild non-abrasive soap and water. In bathrooms specifically, stone tends to attract soap scum, just like man-made tile. Rinse vanity top with clean, hot water frequently.

The use of sealers is also a powerful preventative measure. Your stone was sealed at the factory, but reapplication is necessary over time. How often is determined by the quality of the sealer used, and the frequency of use. We recommend using a penetrating non-toxic sealer for bath areas, but a food-safe sealer is is typically not necessary.

If stains and scratches do occur, there are many things you can do as a consumer to remove them. Remove oil based stains with acetone, mineral spirits, or ammonia. Organic stains like coffee, tea, or juice can be removed with hydrogen peroxide, mixed with a few drops of ammonia.

Water spots or rings are the most common problem with bath vanities, and are caused by minerals left behind when water evaporates. These can be removed by buffing the spots gently with 00 gauge steel wool. Likewise, small nicks and scratches can often be removed the same way. Larger scratches, chips, and resilient stains may require professional help. Please contact your local stonemason for details.

Remember the following list of DOs and DON'Ts:

- ▶ DO use preventative cleaning measures to keep your stone pristine.
- ▶ DO use sealers, applied according to the product specific directions.
- DO blot spills quickly, and wash with mild soap and warm water.
- ▶ DON'T use harsh bathroom cleaners or grout cleaners on any natural stone.
- ▶ DON'T worry if you get a significant stain or scratch that your stone investment is ruined. Virtually anything can be fixed with professional help.

This product has been manufactured and tested to the highest quality standards by Cahaba. We offer our customers thoughtfully crafted fixtures & accessories, engineered for enduring performance over years of use.

#### WHO IS COVERED BY THE WARRANTY
