Installation & Care Instructions



BEFORE YOU START

- Be sure to completely read this installation and maintenance guide before removing vanity top from box and installing.
- **IMPORTANT:** The sidesplash must be installed, secured, plumb, and level. Failure of this step can lead to product damage.
- Cahaba is not responsible for sidesplash if damaged during installation. Be sure to inspect the sink for damage prior to beginning installation.
- Your sidesplash is made of natural stone quarried from the earth. Every slab of natural stone has its own unique characteristics, such as veining and coloration. Be sure to fully inspect your for satisfaction before installation.

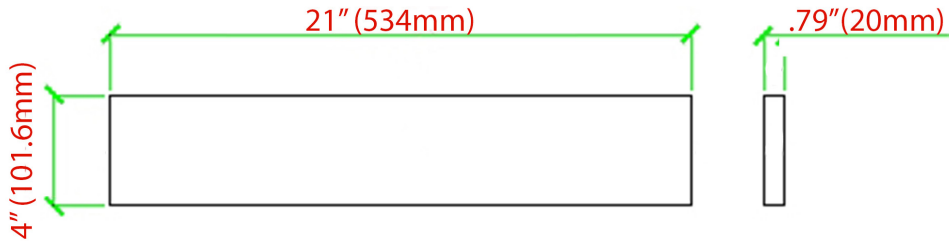

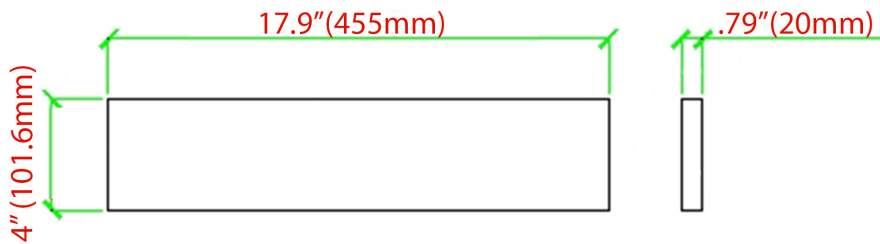
RECOMMENDED TOOLS

- Painter's Tape
- Level
- Framing Square
- Pencil (not permanent marker)
- Caulking Gun
- Silicone Sealant
- Caulking Adhesive
Note: It is our experience that GE Silicone is no the best match with our natural stone products and should be avoided.)

INSTALL THE COUNTERTOP

1. Install the bathroom vanity and vanity top completely per the manufacturer's instructions, if it is not already installed.
2. Dry fit the side splash and position it on the side of the vanity, pushing it as far against the back and side walls as possible. Verify that it fits flush with the edge of the vanity top.
3. Turn the side splash face down and apply caulking adhesive to the side that faces the wall using a circle pattern, which helps it adhere better. Apply an additional strip of silicone sealer along the bottom edge that meets the vanity top.

Press the side splash back into place ensuring that the finished end faces forward. Immediately wipe up any adhesive that oozes out using a damp cloth.

4. Wait until the adhesive dries and apply a bead of silicone along the bottom edge of the side splash where it meets the vanity. Extend the caulk up the rear corner seam where the side splash and the back splash meet.

▶ **IMPORTANT:** *Cahaba is not responsible for sink or countertop if damaged during installation. Be sure to inspect the sidesplash and vanity top for damage prior to beginning installation.*

▶ **IMPORTANT:** *Cahaba sidesplashes should only be fastened to secure, level vanity cabinets.*

Stone products (Granite, Marble, etc.) are surprisingly resilient to stains and scratches. However, as a preventative measure, any spills on the stone surfaces should be wiped up within a reasonable amount of time. Don't let liquid sit on the stone overnight. Stones are most prone to staining by oil and acid, so be sure to blot these spills up as soon as they happen. Follow up by cleaning the stone with a mild non-abrasive soap and water. In bathrooms specifically, stone tends to attract soap scum, just like man-made tile. Rinse vanity top with clean, hot water frequently.

The use of sealers is also a powerful preventative measure. Your stone was sealed at the factory, but reapplication is necessary over time. How often is determined by the quality of the sealer used, and the frequency of use. We recommend using a penetrating non-toxic sealer for bath areas, but a food-safe sealer is typically not necessary.

If stains and scratches do occur, there are many things you can do as a consumer to remove them. Remove oil based stains with acetone, mineral spirits, or ammonia. Organic stains like coffee, tea, or juice can be removed with hydrogen peroxide, mixed with a few drops of ammonia.

Water spots or rings are the most common problem with bath vanities, and are caused by minerals left behind when water evaporates. These can be removed by buffing the spots gently with 00 gauge steel wool. Likewise, small nicks and scratches can often be removed the same way. Larger scratches, chips, and resilient stains may require professional help. Please contact your local stonemason for details.

Remember the following list of DOs and DON'Ts:

- ▶ DO use preventative cleaning measures to keep your stone pristine.
- ▶ DO use sealers, applied according to the product specific directions.
- ▶ DO blot spills quickly, and wash with mild soap and warm water.
- ▶ DON'T use harsh bathroom cleaners or grout cleaners on any natural stone.
- ▶ DON'T worry if you get a significant stain or scratch that your stone investment is ruined. Virtually anything can be fixed with professional help.

- B. The original sales receipt, order number, and/or proof of purchase must be presented at the time of the warranty claim, without exception, for this warranty to be applied to all Cahaba products.

Cahaba will not be held responsible for any damage or product failure due to improper installation, misuse, or failure to use a licensed professional.
