



ADDITIONAL TOOLS (Not Provided)

Note: It is not recommended to use power tools during assembly.

Phillips Head Screwdriver

Note: Wood dowels are intended for alignment. Additional clearance between wood dowel and pre-drilled hole is intentional for ease of assembly.


Please do not use tools to assemble this unit unless specifically indicated.




Reference the images above any time the instructions state "lock the hardware" or "insert hardware and pull down to lock".


Be sure to check all hardware is locked when complete.

Step 1. Attach legs (part I) to bottom panel (part D) using spring washers (part #4), flat washers (part #3), bolts (part #2) and allen wrench (part #7).







Step 4. Attach assembled unit (parts B, C & E) to bottom panel (part D) pull down to lock.




Step 5. Carefully turn unit upright. Insert back panels (parts G & H) into grooves of assembled unit (parts B, C, D & E).



Step 6. Attach top panel (part A) to assembled unit (parts B, C & E) using wood dowels (part #5) and lock the hardware.



- Step 7. Secure back brackets (part #6) at the corner of center back panel (part H) using screws (part #1) and phillips head screwdriver.
- Note: It is important to adjust levelers once fully assembled and upright. Extend adjustable leveler until it's firmly in contact with the floor. If relocating, adjust leveler as needed until it's firmly in contact with the floor in new location. Important: Safety strap kit (part #8) must be installed to preventing tipping, damage
- and /or injury.

SAFETY WALL STRAP INSTALLATION

- Note: It is highly recommended to install this safety strap kit to prevent tipping, damage and/or injury.
- 1. Insert short screw (C) through washer (B) and safety wall strap (E) and attach to top panel (part A) using phillips head screwdriver.
- 2. Drill a 11/32" hole where you want to secure the unit. The drilled hole will be at the same height as the hole in top panel (part A) where the safety wall strap (E) is attached. Tap wall anchor (A) into the hole.
- 3. Insert long screw (D) through washer (B) and safety wall strap (E) into wall anchor (A) using phillips head screwdriver.

Note: This item is not intended for clothing storage use.
