


ADDITIONAL TOOLS (Not Provided)

Note:It is not recommended to use power tools during assembly. However a screw gun can assist with mounting.


Phillips Head Screw Driver


Step 1. Insert Cam Bolts(Part#3)into pre-drilled holes of Parts A,B,C,H(x2) & Part O with a Phillips Head screw driver as shown.



Step 2. Insert Long Wood Dowels (Part#2) into Parts D &ZA as shown.Attach Parts H to to Part D& **Part ZA** with Screws (Part#14)as shown.

Note: Long Wood Dowel (Part#2) will pass completely through Part H.






Step 3. Lay Part O flat on floor as shown. Insert Wood Dowels (Part#1) into Part O.


Attach Part D & ZA to Part O. Attach Part D & ZA to Part O with Cam Locks (Part #4) as shown.


Insert Parts G.




Step 4. Attach Door Catches (Part #12) to Rail E with Round Head Screws (Part #13) as shown. Insert Wood Dowels (Part# 1) into Parts H,G,D & ZA as shown. Set Rails E into place on Rails G & H with Wood Dowels (Part #1) as shown. Secure Rail E to Parts ZA & D using Screws (Part #14) as shown. Attach Rail F to Parts ZA & D using Wood Dowels (Part #1) & Screw (Part #14) as shown.


NOTE: BE SURE THAT SCREWS ARE ALIGNED PROPERLY WITH PRE-DRILLED HOLES IN PARTS D & ZA BEFORE THGHTENNING.







Step 6. Set Rails P into place on Part O using Wood Dowels (Part #1) as shown. Insert Panels Q into the grooves of Parts O & P. Set Rail R onto Rails P & Panels Q with Wood Dowels (Part #1) as shown.







Step 8. Attach Base S to cabinet using Wood Dowels (Part #1),
Hex Socket Head Bolts (Part #8), & Barrel Nuts (Part #9)
as shown. Now attach legs using Hex Socket Head
Bolts & Wood Dowels (as shown in instruction
manual included in carton with legs). Attach 2 Support
Leg ZB or ZC under the Bottom Panel S. Support Leg ZC is
for use only with Bun Foot. All other Legs styles will use support
leg ZB. Carefully turn cabinet over so that legs are on the floor.






Step 9. Attach Top A to cabinet using Wood Dowels & Cam Locks as shown.






Step 10. Attach Drawer Front V to Drawer Sides W & X with Screws (Part #5) using Phillips Head screwdriver as shown. NOTE: BE SURE THAT WHEELS ON DRAWER GLIDES ARE FACING OUTWARD, AND ARE AT THE OPPOSITE SIDE OF THE DRAWER FRONT. Slide Bottom Panel Z into grooves of Parts W & X as shown. Attach Back Panel Y to Side Panels W & X with Screws (Part #5) using Phillips Head screwdriver as shown. Repeat this step for the other two drawers. Attach Hardware Knobs (Part #6) to Drawer Fronts V with Round Head Bolt (Part #7) as shown. Insert drawers into their appropriate positions.




Step 11. Insert Shelf Holders (Part #10) into desired positions. Insert Shelves I & Shelf J into desired position.

NOTE: IF YOU INTEND TO USE THE WINE STORAGE GRIDS, SHELF J MUST BE PLACED IN THE CENTER HOLE POSITIONS TO FIT CORRECTLY.





Step 12. Slide Parts U & Part T together as shown. Repeat this step for other Wine storage grid. Making sure that Shelf J is placed in the center hole position, carefully insert the wine storage grids into place in the center portion of the cabinet.



Step 13. Attach Hardware Knobs (Part #6) to the doors with Round Head Bolts (Part #7) using Phillips Head screwdriver as shown. Attach doors to cabinet by placing bottom Pin Hinge into pre-drilled holes in Base S & depressing top spring loaded Pin Hinge to fit door into place in Rail E. Note: Be sure Pin Hinges (top & bottom) have fully extended into the pre-drilled holes

in Base S and Rail E to secure doors into place.







SAFTY WALL STRAP ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTION

- 1) Insert Short Screw(Part#C)through Washer(Part#B) and Safty Wall Starp(Part#E) and screw it into Parts A.
- 2) Drill a 9mm hole at a point where you want to secrue/attach your Kitchen Cart. Make sure that the height of the hole being drilled into the wall is equal to the height of the hole in part A.Tap Wall Anchor (Part #A) into the hole.
- 3) Insert Long Screw (Part#D) through a Washer (Part #B) and Wall Safty Strap (Part#E) into Wall Enchor (Part#A).

Note: This item is not intended for clothing storage use.
