





① Bolt (M8*25)		x 4
② Spring Washer (M8)	0	x 4
3 Flat Washer (M8)	0	x 4
4 Nut (M8)	(	x 4
⑤ Nut Cap (M8)	$\bigcirc$	x 4
6 Bolt (M6*30)		x 8
Tlast Washer (M6)	0	x 8
8 Bolt Cap (M6)	0	x 8

Step 1: Place Top (A) upside down on a soft cloth.


Insert all Cylinder Bolts (Part #1) into the pre-drilled holes of Top (A).

Step 2: Attach two adjacent Legs (B) to Top (A) by inserting the Cylinder Bolts (Part #1) through the holes in the ends of the Legs (B). Now secure the Legs (B) using Flat Washers (Part #3), Spring Washers (Part #2) & Nuts (Part #4).

Note - -Tighten Nuts only half way using wrench (#9) .



Step 3: Attach Stretcher (C) to attached Legs (B) using Flat Washers (Part #7),and Bolts (Part #6) as shown. Note - Tighten Nuts only half way with wrench (#9).Now attach the other two Legs (B) to Top (A) & Stretcher (C) using the same method as the first two legs. Tighten all bolts completely with wrench (#9).



Step 4: Cover all Nuts and bolts with Nut Caps (Part #5) & Bolt Caps (Part #8). Turn the table over into the upright position in your congratulations! You are finished.
