




Step 1.Lay arm panel (part A) down on a soft flat surface, such as carpet, as shown below.

Attach back panel (part B) to arm panel (part A) using medium bolts(part #2),


washers (part #5),nuts(part #4),wrench(part #6) and allen key (part #7).

NOTE: Please do not fully tighten bolts until unit is fully assembled.




Step 2.Attach seat panel (part C) to arm panel (part A) and back panel (part B) using long bolts(part #3), washers (part #5), nuts (part #4), wrench (part #6) and allen key (part #7).

NOTE: Please do not fully tighten bolts until unit is fully assembled.




Step 3.Attach front panel (part D) to arm panel (part A) and seat panel (part C) using short bolts (part #1), long bolts (part #3), washers (part #5), nuts (part #4), wrench (part #6) and allen key (part #7).


NOTE: Please do not fully tighten bolts until unit is fully assembled.




Step 4.Attach side panel (part E) to assembled unit (parts B,C&D) using short bolts (part #1), medium bolts (part #2), washers (part #5), nuts (part #4), wrench (part #6) and allen key (part #7).




Step 5. Screw adjustable levelers (part #8) to desired position in the pre-drilled holes on the bottom of the chair where shown.



Step 6.Insert core of seat cushion (part G) into cover of seat cushion (part F).
Insert core of back cushion (part I) into cover of back cushion (part H).
Insert core of side cushion (part K) into cover of side cushion (part J).





Step 8.Use plastic clips (part #9) to secure additional units together as shown.
