PREPARATION

• Before You Begin

Before installing any Dawn product in your new or remodeled kitchen, you should make sure that you are in compliance with all local plumbing codes.

• Check The Accessory Items

Before installation, please check the condition of the product and, if appropriate, its components. If there is any problem with the product and/or its components, please contact the store you purchased it from for a replacement. As soon as you have inspected your product, please return it to its original packaging until you are ready to install it.

• Handle With Care

Your stainless steel sink may be very heavy and may possibly require more than one person to lift it. To protect its finish and avoid damage before and after installation, please handle your sink with care. For care and cleaning tips on Dawn Stainless Steel Sinks after installation, please refer to the *Maintenance* section of this instruction guide.

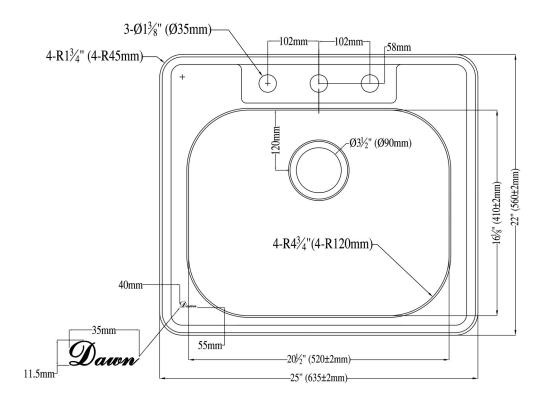

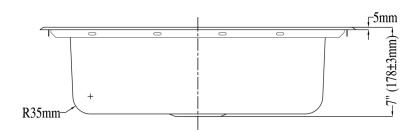

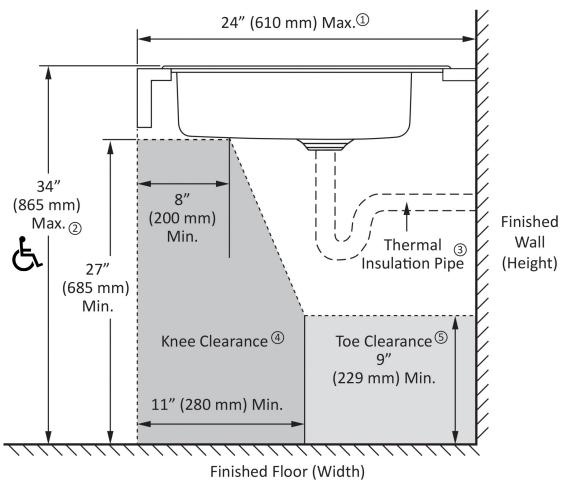




ADA COMPLIANT TOP MOUNT SINK INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

IMPORTANT: Recommended for professional installers only. The installer maintains responsibility for installing the product safely and correctly.

Recommended Installation Diagram for Dawn's ADA Compliant Top Mount Sink



Remarks:

A clear floor space must meet the minimum width of 48" (1220 mm), and the length of 30" (760 mm) for forward approach to get access to the ADA compliant sink.

- 1 The width of the counter top cannot exceed 24".
- ② The maximum height from the bottom of the finished floor to the counter top cannot exceed 34" (865 mm). For children between the ages of 6 to 12, the maximum height must be 31" (785 mm).
- (3) Thermal Insulation pipe is required to be used for ADA compliant sink.
- (4) Knee clearance area/open space: the height of this area measuring from the finished floor to the underneath area of the sink is required to be at least 27" (685 mm); the width is required to be at least 8" (200 mm) from under the sink bottom area and at least 11"width (280 mm) from above the finished floor area.
- (5) Toe clearance area: the height of this area measuring from the finished floor to the bottom of the thermal insulation pipe is required to be at least 9" (229 mm); the length is required to be at least 30" (760 mm).

The sink listed in this installation instructions manual is compliant to ADA and ANSI/ICC A117.1. For complete details regarding ADA complaint sink installation regulations, please refer to these specific sections under ANSI/ICC A117.1: Section 305 Clear Floor Space, Section 306 Knee and Toe Clearance, Section 606 Lavatories and Sinks.

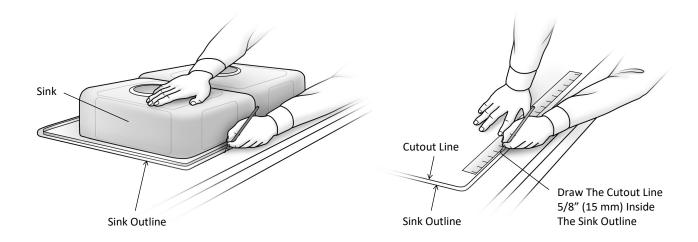
INSTALLATION STEPS

IMPORTANT: Recommended for professional installers only. The installer maintains responsibility for installing the product safely and correctly.

* Each Dawn ADA Complaint Top Mount Sink package includes: one Dawn ADA Compliant Top Mount Sink, eight pieces of mounting clips, and one ADA Compliant Sinks Installation Instructions (any other suggested materials & tools are not included).

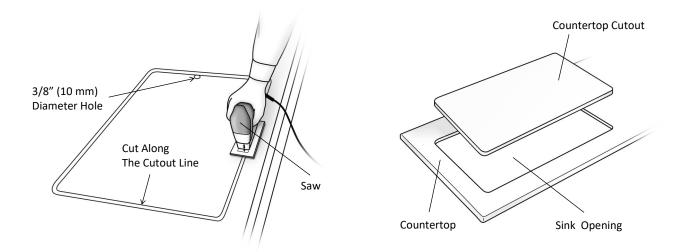
• STEP 1: Create A Cutout Template

Measure and mark the centerline of the sink's position and alignment with the cabinet and countertop. To create a template, place the sink upside down on the countertop and draw around it with a pencil to make the sink outline. Remove the sink. Draw another line 5/8" (15mm) inside the sink outline, and this line will be the sink cutout line.



STEP 2: Make The Sink Cutout

Drill a 3/8" (10mm) diameter hole on the inside of the cutout line. Insert the saw blade into the hole and cut along the cutout line to create a precise opening on the countertop. Trim and smooth the edge of the opening with sandpaper.

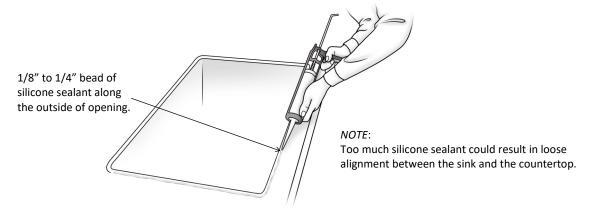

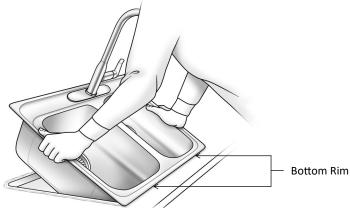

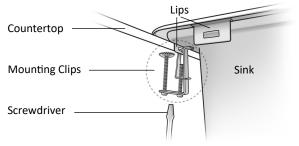
• STEP 3: Installing Top Mount Sink
Insert the sink into the opening and examine the fit. Make sure the sink is aligned with the opening and is well supported by the countertop. Remove the sink and adjust the opening if necessary. If your sink comes ready to receive the faucet, install the faucet and drain now. Clean the countertop with denatured alcohol. Apply a 1/8" (3.2mm) to 1/4" (6.4mm) bead of silicone sealant all the way along the outside of the opening without missing any areas.



To install the sink, first insert the sink into the opening by attaching the bottom rim of the sink to the countertop. Make sure the rim sits on, and covers the silicone sealant. Then, place the sink completely into the opening, making sure the sink fits properly onto the countertop. Verify the sink is level on both front to back and left to right sides. Immediately wipe away any excess sealant with a damp cloth.



STEP 4: Install The Mounting Clips
 Hook the mounting clips from the underside of the sink onto the lips on the back of the sink rim. Tighten the screws to pull the sink down tight against the countertop. Do not overtighten.



NOTE: Tightening the mounting clips may cause the silicone sealant to squeeze out from under the sink lips. Wipe away the excess sealant with a damp cloth.

MAINTENANCE

Care and cleaning instructions for Dawn stainless steel sinks:

Clean regularly with clean water and/or a mild detergent solution applied with a soft cloth or sponge. Rinse thoroughly and towel dry after every use to prevent water spots and mineral deposits from building up on the surface of the sink. Deep clean once a week with an approved cleanser and a soft cloth or sponge rather than an occasional aggressive single cleaning - be sure to rub in the direction of the finish lines. Cleaners should state approved or suitable for stainless steel.

Scratches

Like most metallic surfaces, stainless steel sinks will get scratches. These are usage scratches and will blend in with the overall finish of your sink over time. There are steps that can be taken to reduce the appearance of scratches:

Use a nylon pad with an iron free abrasive polishing compound. Follow the direction of the original polish lines to blend out the scratch in a small area. Be cautious not to overdo the process. A too aggressive procedure will result in a bright spot.

Water Quality

Regular routine cleaning can usually prevent lime scale deposits from hard water. Do not allow excessive build up before treating. Soaking in a 25% vinegar solution can treat hard water spots. Periodically rub with a synthetic scouring pad, then rinse and towel dry.

Rust Marks

If you develop rust marks due to presence of or contact with materials containing iron, swab sink with a sponge dipped in a diluted solution of (10-15%) nitric acid (HN03) and follow with routine cleaning. Avoid prolonged contact of materials containing iron with your stainless steel sink.

Do's and Don'ts

- Do regular routine cleaning rather than an occasional aggressive single cleaning.
- Only use cleaners that state "SUITABLE FOR STAINLESS STEEL".
- Always rinse and dry as the final step in a cleaning procedure.
- If there is any accidental contact of the sink with photographic chemicals or soldering fluxes, immediately rinse and clean the sink with water.
- Do not leave low-carbon steel or iron kitchenware in the sink.
- Do not leave rubber patches, wet sponges, cloths, cleaning pads, or dishpans in the sink.
- Do not use coarse abrasive powders, metallic scourers such as steel wool or brushes with metal bristles.
- Do not leave standing solutions of chlorine bleach and water in the sink.
- Do not allow liquid soap or other cleansers to dry on the surface of the sink.
- Do not leave food with high-salt content such as pickles, béarnaise sauce or mustard in the sink.
- Do not use cleaning products containing silver, sulfur or hydrochloric acid.
- Do not leave metal or rusted materials in the sink.
- Do not rub the sink with metal scrubbing pads.
- Do not use the sink as a cutting board.

WARRANTY

All Dawn® products have a limited lifetime warranty unless otherwise noted. Dawn® products have been manufactured and tested to the highest quality standards by Dawn Kitchen & Bath Products, Inc. ("Dawn®"). Dawn® warranties are limited to Dawn® products purchased and installed in the United States. Original invoice number provided by a Dawn authorized dealer will be required as proof of purchase.

Limited Lifetime Warranty

Dawn® warranties all of its products to be free from manufacturing defects in material and workmanship during normal residential use. This warranty only extends to the original consumer and is non-transferable. If any defect is found in normal residential use, Dawn® will, at its own election, repair, provide a replacement part of product, or make appropriate adjustment at no charge, (labor charges and other incidental or consequential costs are not included). Damage to a product caused by accident, misuse, or abuse is NOT covered by this warranty. Improper care and cleaning will void the warranty. If Dawn® is unable to provide a replacement and a repair cannot be made, Dawn® may elect to refund the purchase price to the original consumer/purchaser in exchange for the return of the product. (IMPORTANT: The original consumer/purchaser is responsible for inspecting products upon arrival. Any defective product should be reported immediately and should NOT be installed.)

One-Year Limited Warranty

Dawn® sinks and kitchen accessories are warranted to be free of defects in material and workmanship for one year from date of purchase. Dawn® will, at its own election, repair, replace or make appropriate adjustment where Dawn® inspection discloses any such defects occurring in normal usage within one (1) year after purchase. Dawn® is not responsible for removal or installation costs. This warranty voids if the products have been moved from its original installation place. Defective parts or products will be replaced on availability basis. Warranty does not apply to any local building codes, make sure to check your local plumbing codes before installation. As wood ages a natural process causes the wood to darken, this is not a defect and if a replacement part is needed we cannot guarantee exact color or grain match.

DAWN WARRANTIES DO NOT COVER, AND DAWN DISCLAIMS ANY LIABILITY FOR:

- Conditions or damage NOT resulting from defects in material or workmanship.
- Conditions or damage resulting from:

RETURN POLICY

You may only return new, uninstalled, or unused items sold and fulfilled by Dawn Kitchen & Bath Products, Inc. for a full ref und within 30 days of delivery. Items must be returned in its original package. Returns of used items or returns after 30 days of delivery may be accepted with a 15% restocking fee. Dawn will pay for return shipping costs only if the return is a result of our fault. If you receive a faulty product and need to exchange it for the same product, please contact our customer service via phone, fax, or e-mail to request a replacement. If you would like to exchange a product for a different one, please first return the original product to our location at 27688 Industrial Blvd., Hayward, CA 94545 and then place a new order.
