
CAUTION

- Required supply circuit: 110 130V/60Hz
- Labeled wires are "L" for live wire, "N" for neutral wire, "E" for ground wire.
- Never install fixture on damp ceiling, the room should be dry and well ventilated
- All electrical components must be installed by a licensed electrician and in accordance with the National Electrical Code and the appropriate local electrical codes.



Canopy Installation Instruction




IMPORTANT: Test sockets with bulb before dressing the fixture.

- 1.Drill a $\not\!\! 00.7''$ hole in the ceiling reinforcment to allow a $^{11}\!\!/_{16}''$ threaded rod to pass through.
- 2 .Attach the electrical box to the ceiling reinforcment and pass the $^{11}\!\!/_{\!6}$ threaded rod through the box and secure it to the heavy duty hickey.
- 3 . Pass the fixture wires and ground wire through the loop, canopy ring, center hole of canopy and the heavy duty hickey.
- 4 .Pull ceiling wires down through the fixture box and make connection.
- 5 .Screw loop only onto threaded pipe.
- 6 . Hang the fixture on chain.
- 7 .Secure the canopy with canopy ring.



Canopy Installation Instruction




Please read all instructions carefuly. Before you proceed to install, make sure that the power supply is tamed off and off until installation is complete. Please note that each part has been asigned a letter. Please proceed in alphabetical order.

- 1. Fix the crossbar(ZA) to the ceiling with the two crossbar screws.
- 2. Hang the Canopy ring(ZC) back up over the canopy(ZB), through metal rod(ZD) together.
- 3. Hang the electric main and ground wire through the chain(ZE), the Metal rod(ZD), the Loop and the crossbar(ZA) until the end of the electric main reaches the junction box where you can make the appropriate connections.
- 4. Be sure when connecting the wire use electrician approved junction caps.
- 5. Stow the excess wire in the junction box(ZA).
- 6. Raise the canopy (ZB).
- 7. Canopy ring(ZC), attach canopy(ZB) to ceiling, slide metal ring (ZC) over canopy lock(ZD) and hold the canopy(ZB).

Frame Assembly Instructions

Installation:

Please read all instructions carefully.

Before you proceed to install, make sure.

that the power supply is turned off and

remains off until installation is complete.

Please note that each part has been assigned a number.

Please proceed in a numerical order.

- 1. Fix the crossbar to the junction to the ceiling.
- 2. Unscrew the threaded pipe (02) of the loop, hang the ceiling canopy (01) into the pipe (02) on the ring, then screw the pipe (02) to the heavy duty hickey.
- 3. Hang the chain (03) to the threaded pipe (02) the end of the loop with the safe lock.
- 4. Unscrew the M5screws of the steel plate(04), then assemble the lamp arm(11, 16) to the steel plate(04) and fix them with the screws, then hang the lamp body which already assembled well on the chain(03) the end of the safe lock.
- 5. Connect wires at the steel plate (04), then pull down the main wire though the 32'' threaded pipe (18) to the end and screw the pipe (18) to the steel plate (04).
- 6. Hang the cover (05), 7'' glass dish(A) and ring (06), in order to though the pipe (18) and fix with the ring (06).
- 7. Fix the steel plate(07) to the 32"threaded pipe(18). Unscrew the M5screws of the steel plate(07), then assemble the lamp arm(13, 17) to the steel plate(07) and fix them with the screws.
- 8. Connect the wires and the main wires at the steel plate(07) correctly, pull down the main wires though the 22"threaded pipe(19) to the end.
- 9. Hang the cover (08), 8 glass dish(B) and ring (19), in order to though the pipe (19) and fix with the ring (19).
- 10. Connect the lamp body which already assembled well with the lamp arm(12).
- 11. Unscrew the tower shaped (10-4), break up the parts (10-1 $^{\sim}$ 10-3), then fix the steel plate (10-1) to the 22"threaded pipe (19)
- 12. Unscrew the M5screws of the steel plate(10-1), then assemble the lamp arm(14) to the steel plate(10-1) and fix them with the screws, and connect the fixture which already assembled well to the lamp arm(13, 17), then fix the lamp arm(14) with the lamp arm(15).
- 13. Connect the wires at the steel plate (10-1) with the main wire correctly, then add the 8"glass dish(C) and assemble the parts $(10-1^{\sim}10-3)$ with the tower shaped (10-4).
- 14. Pull the main wire which already connected well, pass the chain(03) and the threaded pipe(02) to the junction box, then connect wires at the box correctly.
- 15. Fix the ceiling canopy (01) with the ring to the ceiling.
- 16. As the crystal dressing instruction, hang the crystal parts.


NOTE: The fixture have the steel wire, you can't cut it, please use the steel wire and pull up it to the canopy to fix the fixture.

Step 4 Crystal Dressing Instructions

- 1. Hang crystal "A"、"B"、"C"、"D"、"E"、"F"、"G"、
 "H"、"I"、"J"、"K"、"L"、"M"、"N"、"O"、"P"、
 "Q"、"R"、"S".
- 2. Connect both ends of Z3 with A, Connect both ends of Z2 with C, Connect both ends of Z1 with F, Connect both ends of Z with H, Connect both ends of Y with I, Connect both ends of W with J, Connect both ends of W with K, Connect both ends of V with L, Connect both ends of U with M, Connect both ends of T with N.

When dressing the chandelier with the crystals please remember to wear either rubber or cotton gloves. So as to prevent any damage or smudging on the crystals.

Cleaning and Maintenance of Crystals Wet a soft cotton fabric in clean warm water and wipe gently, then polish with a dry soft cotton fabric.

with this product and circle the items you wish

orders must be pre-paid.
