

APRON BATHTUB INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Important Information


The bath must only be supported by the feet or base. Do not support the bath by the rim.

Before installing a rim-mount bath faucet, refer to the online product specification sheet. Ensure clearance under the rim before drilling faucet holes in the rim.


Provide adequate floor support. Refer to the specification sheet for specific floor-loading requirements.

Make sure the subfloor is level. Provide drain access from below. Provide access to all plumbing connections. Observe all local building and plumbing


Conventional woodworking tools and materials for better installation




Drop cloth




5. For adhesive installation, apply a generous amount of construction adhesive to the bath feet or base.




9. If there are gaps, fill them with a shim.




2. Install the rough plumbing.




6. With help, lift the bath into position. Verify level. Ensure the feet or base are fully supported.




10. Secure the flange to the stud with galvanized nails or screws.




13. Install the finished wall and deck to within 1/16" (2 mm) of the bath rim.



3. Install the drain to the bath.



7. Connect the bath drain to the drain pipe. Position a protective liner in the bath basin.



11. Secure 1/4" (6 mm) furring strips to the studs to be flush with the bath flange.



12. Install water-resistant wallboard over the framing. Apply 100% silicone sealant along the seam.

4. For mortar bed installation, set the

basin area in 1" (25 mm) to 2" (51 mm)

of mortar cement.

8. Drill small pilot holes

through the flange

at the studs.
