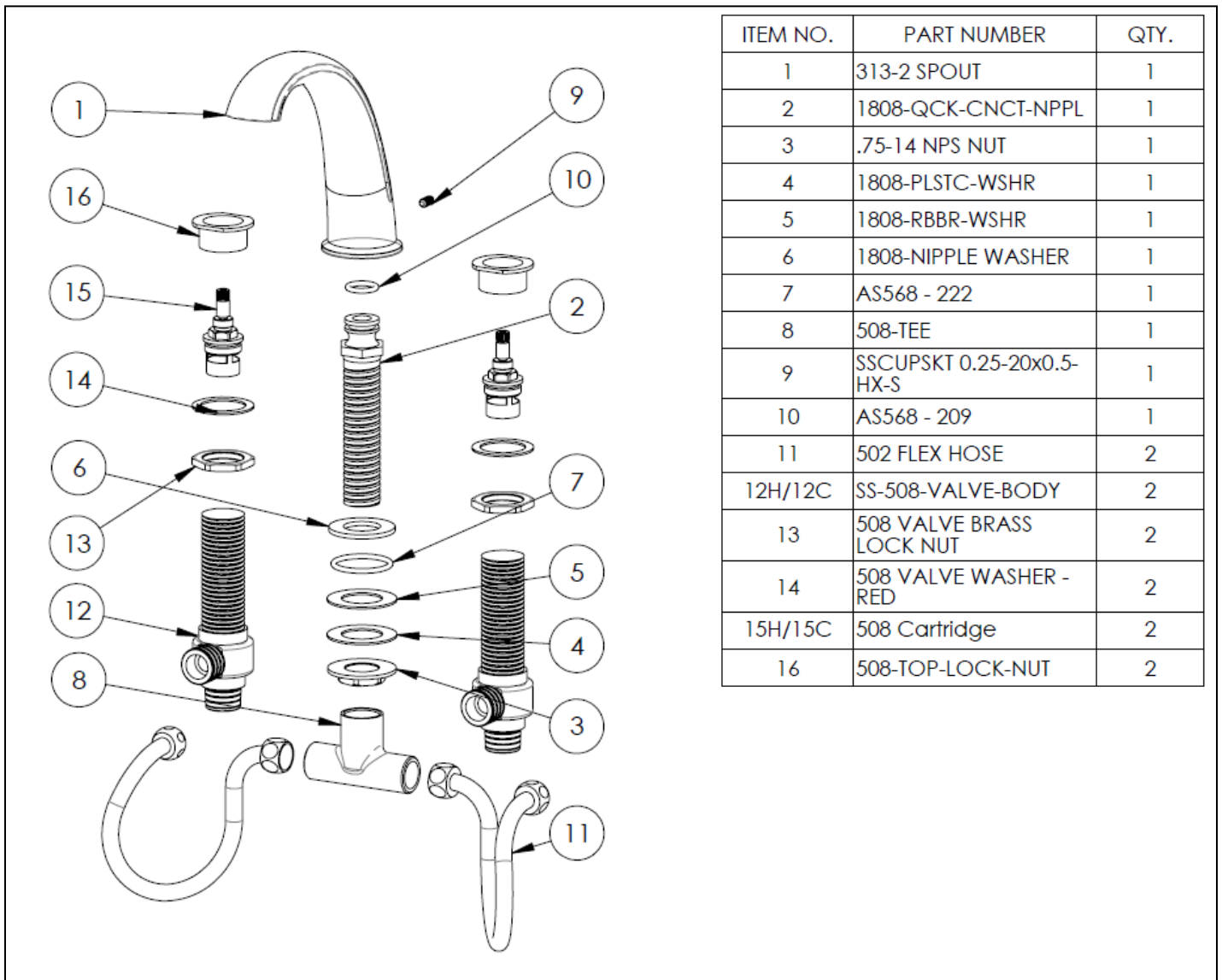


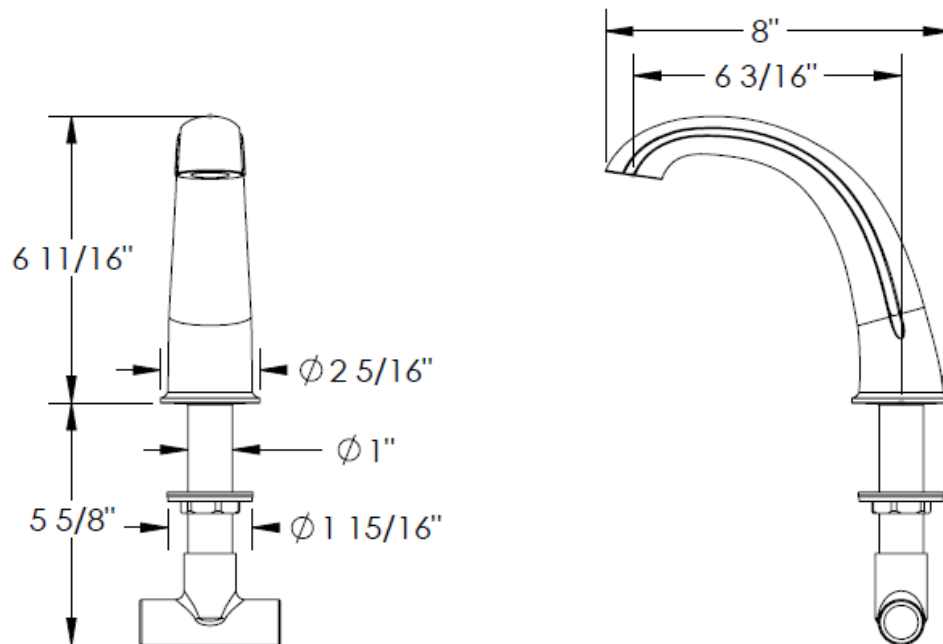

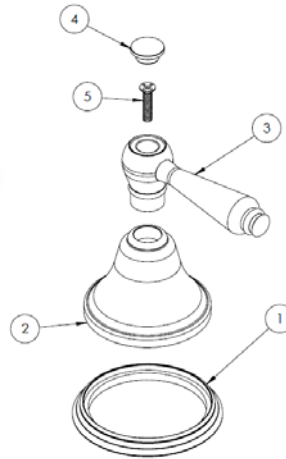

1. **Carefully remove all parts from the box.**
2. **Begin by first installing the Spout.**
 - a. Remove the "T" Assembly (8) and spout lock nut (3) from the Spout (1).
 - b. Drop the Spout through the hole in your countertop or sink.
 - c. Tighten the Lock Nut (3) against the underside of mounting surface .
 - d. Re-assemble "T" Assembly onto bottom of Spout.
3. **Identify your Hot and Cold Valves.**
 - a. Remove all trim from Valve Assembly (including Top Lock Nut [16] where applicable), leaving Bottom Lock Nut (13).
 - b. Begin to tighten the Valve to your countertop or sink with a Top Lock Nut (16) (Refer to Diagram) but do not tighten completely.
 - c. Install Escutcheon and Handle (refer to "Handle Trims" section) on valve body (12). Be sure that bottom of handle properly clears top of the Escutcheon.
 - d. Once you have adjusted the Valve height, remove Handle and proceed to tighten Valve from the bottom until it is snug.
 - e. Install Handle on the Valve.
4. **Connect the two Flex Hoses (11) to "T" Assembly (8) and to the HOT (12H) and COLD (12C) valves respectively.**
These hoses can be bent or twisted, but be careful not to kink the hoses or you will have limited water supply and excessive noise from the faucet.
5. **Begin by bleeding the water lines before connecting to the valves. Connect water supplies to bottom of each valve.**
6. **Flush faucet by running both Hot and Cold water in full open position.**
7. **Check for leaks. If leaks or problems occur, re-tighten all nuts before consulting a plumber.**

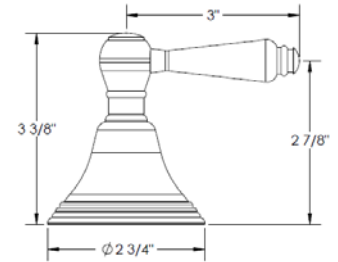

- DO NOT USE PLUMBER'S PUTTY ON ANY OF THE BRASS COMPONENTS
This will cause the finish to tarnish and void the warranty. A non-corrosive Silicone is recommended.
- DURING SWEATING OF LINES DO NOT OVERHEAT CASTING
Overheating may cause damage to internal mechanism
- COPPER ADAPTORS MAY BE REQUIRED TO COMPLETE YOUR INSTALLATION
